Know your Rights and Access Care

On a national, state, and local level, you have rights, and you have options for access to comprehensive reproductive health care, including abortion care. Do you have questions about those rights and options? See the relevant resources below.

What I'm Doing

I am a strong defender of a woman's right to choose and I am outraged by the U.S. Supreme Court's decision to strike down Roe v. Wade. Decided 50 years ago, Roe protects a woman's most basic rights to freedom and privacy under federal law.

As a member of the House Pro-Choice Caucus, I was an original cosponsor of H.R. 3755, the Women's Health Protection Act of 2021, which would federally protect a women's right to choose and prevent states from imposing burdensome requirements on accessing reproductive health services. I was proud to vote for H.R. 3755, which passed the House by a margin of 218-211 in September 2021. I have rejoined this legislation once again this year.

Further, in both last Congress and this Congress, I have been an original cosponsor of H.R. 2234, the Equal Access to Abortion Coverage in Health Insurance (EACH) Act. This bill would effectively repeal the Hyde Amendment, ensuring federal health care programs provide coverage for abortion services, and would further require federal facilities to provide access to those services. I also support H.R. 8297, the Ensuring Access to Abortion Act, which would protect the right to access abortion services across state lines, and the SAFE for Patients Act, which would protect abortion providers, patients, and facilities from extremist violence and harassment.

I strongly support access to abortion and other reproductive health care abroad. To that end, I was an original cosponsor of H.R. 556, the Global HER Act.

I will continue to look for avenues through which to protect and expand reproductive health and autonomy in the 118th Congress.
