I am requesting funding for the Ipswich Infrastructure Storm Repairs and Upgrades Project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Town of Ipswich Department of Public Works, located at 25 Green Street, Ipswich, MA 01938. The funding would be used to replace and modernize an aging culvert on Ipswich Road. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will provide long-term, permanent risk reduction to individuals and property from flooding hazards and bolster a vulnerable part of the watershed.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by section 203 of the Stafford Act (42 U.S.C. 5133), as amended by Section 1234, National Public Infrastructure Pre-Disaster Hazard Mitigation, of the Disaster Recovery Reform Act (DRRA) of 2018.
